230	<p><b>Puligny Montrachet "Le Trezin", Domaine Joseph Colin. Burgundy. France 2019</b> Joseph owns a tiny plot (¾ s of an acre) of Puligny, so this wine is as rare as the proverbial hens' teeth! Sublime and hugely satisfying, the epitome of fine wine with its elegance and balance.</p>	£ 105.00
231	<p><b>Pouilly Fuisse, Terres de Menhir, Domaine Gilles Morat. Burgundy. France 2021</b> Fabulous white Burgundy. A lean and mineral core with a ripe and supple fruitiness. Morat is a top proponent of this sought after village.</p>	£ 72.00
232	<p><b>Savigny Les Beaune Blanc, Domaine Lebreuil. Burgundy. France 2020</b> Rare! This is a "field blend," which contains not just Chardonnay, but extremely unusually, also Pinot Blanc! The grapes are fermented together and the result is magnificent. The Pinot Blanc gives a little ripeness and the end result reminds us of Meursault in style.</p>	£ 78.00
233	<p><b>Chablis Premier Cru Mont de Milieu. Dom. Nathalie and Gilles Fevre. Burgundy. France 2020</b> One of the finest vineyards in Chablis in the hands of two of the best winemakers results in only one thing. The best example you will find from this famous village. A mouth full of exquisite, steely, lip-smacking cool fruit and a long and satisfying clean dry finish.</p>	£ 79.00
234	<p><b>Saint Aubin, Domaine Joseph Colin, Burgundy. France 2020</b> Joseph Colin is at the top of his game, although in the 2021 vintage he has lost more than 60% of his crop to late Spring frosts. What remains is exceptional. This Saint Aubin is pure and vivid with great mouth feel and a lingering finish.</p>	£ 83.00
235	<p><b>Meursault, Domaine Edmond Cornu, Burgundy. France 2020</b> Edmond is very traditional, as are his wines, his Meursault is perfect. Alluring and complex aromatics and a beguiling and comely fruit, that easily entices you into desiring a second glass.</p>	£ 91.00
236	<p><b>"Red Shoulder Ranch". Shafer Vineyards. Napa Valley. USA 2019</b> One of the most highly regarded wineries in the States. This single and perfectly sited vineyard shows off their white winemaking skills to perfection. Elegant and lithe, honeysuckle, melon, apricot and pineapple all jostle for your attention. Careful oak ageing lends a welcome structure to this stunning wine.</p>	£ 89.00

247	<b>Barolo "Badarina", Michele Reverdito. Piedmont. Italy 2015</b> Badarina is an exceptional single vineyard from which the mercurial Michele produces stunning Barolo. Intense, complex, and mellow with a lovely, lean finish.	£ 93.00
248	<b>Chorey Les Beaune, Les Bons Ores. Domaine Edmond Cornu. Bourgogne. France 2020</b> A great introduction to fine red Burgundy. (Before you progress to the Nuits Saint Georges further down the list!). 249	<b>Nuits Saint Georges Premier Cru. Domaine Chauvenet. Burgundy. France 2016</b> Extra bottle maturation adds even more finesse to this near perfect expression of Red Burgundy. 202	<b>Chateau de Chamirey, Mercurey Premier Cru. La Mission. Burgundy. France 2014</b> Another fine Monopole wine from the Devillard family. It is a wine which effortlessly balances tangerine and lemon flavours with ripe spiced peaches and a tight mineral texture.	£ 70.00
204	<b>Meursault, les Grand Charrons. Burgundy. France 2020</b> Rich and voluptuous Meursault. This is an elegant and deeply complex wine. There is a captivating palate of white fruits, sublime honeyed richness and a hint of toasted oak.	£ 79.00

### Aged to Perfection – red wine

211	<b>Chateau Grand Puy, Lacoste Pauillac. Bordeaux. France 2005</b> Pure cassis, liquorice and spiced are all present in this wine from Xavier Borie. Medium to full bodied.	£ 160.00
212	<b>Chateau Pichon Longueville, Pauillac, Cru Classe. Bordeaux. France 2005</b> Sweet blackcurrant, lots of cedar wood with a medium to full body and a long finish. This is a beauty and one of the most successful Pauillacs of this vintage.	£ 190.00
