230	Domaine Jean Chartron Puligny-Montrachet Village. France. 2023 Classic, elegant Puligny, pretty aromas of white peach, spring flowers and pastry cream, followed by a medium to full-bodied, ample palate.	£ 125.00
231	Domaine Cornin Pouilly-Fuisse 1er Cru 'Les Chevrieres. France. 2021 Terroir driven with stone fruit and minerality, backed up by a fine thread of acidity. Fermentation and maturation in French oak demi-muids impart a slightly fuller palate which maintains remarkable balance.	£85.00
232	Domaine Larue Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Sous Le Puits'. France. 2023 The Larues are meticulous and precise in all aspects of winegrowing and winemaking, and their wines reflect these qualities. The "Sous Le Puits" is sourced from parcels close to the hamlet of Blagny bordering the Meursault appellation, at the top of the hill of Puligny-Montrachet.	£130.00
234	Domaine Vincent Gaudry Sancerre Blanc 'Tournebride'. France. 2023 A firm favourite showcasing the expected gooseberry and citrus characters, this Sancerre has incredible balance and depth. Truly representative of Vincent Gaudy's profound belief in the philosophy of biodynamic winemaking.	£73.00
241	Domaine Usseglio Raymond & Fils Chateauneuf-du-Pape Rouge Tradition. France. 2023 A beautifully balanced Châteauneuf-du-Pape, showing ripe red and black fruits—think raspberry, black cherry, and plum—layered with notes of thyme, lavender, and warm spice. Silky tannins and a touch of earthy minerality ground the wine, while vibrant acidity keeps it fresh and focused. Classic, generous, and true to its southern Rhône roots.	£79.00
242	Chateau Bouquey St-Emilion Grand Cru. France. 2019 On the palate, it reveals a harmonious blend of ripe fruit, smooth tannins, and balanced acidity, leading to a long, satisfying finish.	£62.00
